Message from the President: Lifeline our PET project!

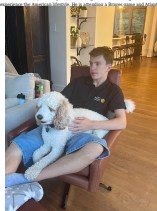

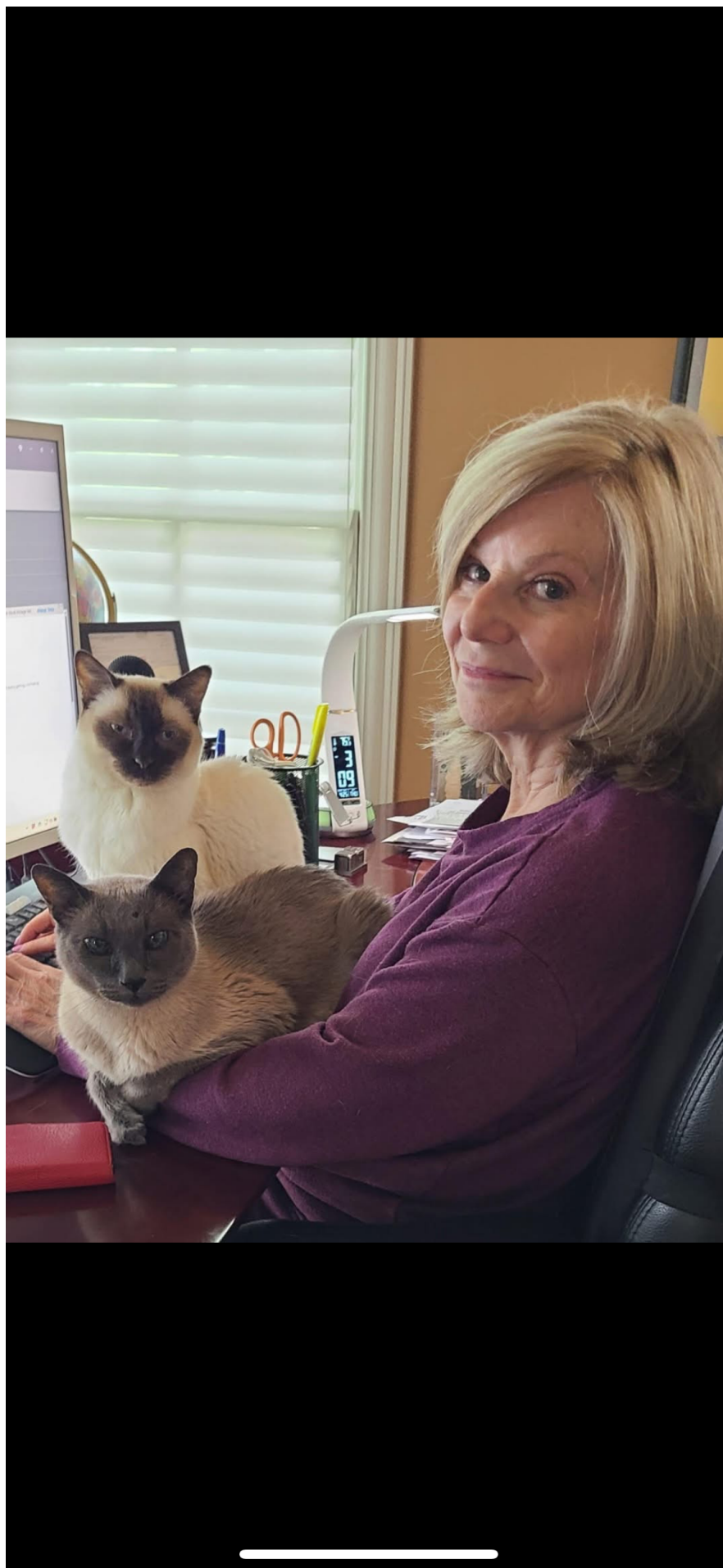
