**Message from the President: 10.30.23**

As we heard Robert Hall share with us at Monday's meeting, Polio remains endemic in only two countries, Afghanistan and Pakistan. But the right care is there. This highly infectious disease can cause paralysis, lifelong disability, or death, mostly in young children. With no cure, vaccination is the only defense. Global eradication is vital to prevent resurgence, protect future generations, and mark one of humanity's greatest public health achievements. Rotary International is committed to raising \$50 million per year over the next three years, with every dollar to be matched with two additional dollars from the Bill and Melinda Gates Foundation. This expanded agreement translates into a total of \$450 million to support the Global Polio Eradication Initiative. That's a 1:1 match for every donation made to Polio Plus!  
The PolioPlus Society is a program to promote individual giving in PolioPlus. Members of the Society agree to give at least \$100 annually toward polio eradication until polio is stamped out worldwide. And who knows, donations can also be made in your pet's name!
